Both State and Commonwealth governments support traineeships in different ways through the user choice policy which allows employers to select the training provider of their choice. Support may include:

- Payment for the training or
- Incentives

An Australian Apprenticeship Centre can assist you in determining the incentives and handle all of the paperwork.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Do I have to release staff for face to face training?

A. This is up to you and the trainee. Various support is available.

Q. What is provided to the trainee?

A. A range of resources and assessment tasks, all relevant to the workplace, along with phone, email and support visits.

Q. How long is a traineeship?

A. Traineeships have a nominal length of time depending on the qualification. However once all assessments tasks are completed and the employer is satisfied with the work outcomes, early completion of the contract may be available.

Q. How many staff do I need to have as trainees?

A. As many as you want; or just one. The more trainees you have it may be more suitable to schedule regular face to face sessions.

Q. Are traineeships popular?

A. Some statistics for the past 12 months are that 4078 traineeships in FLM IV, 403 traineeships in Aged Care III, 365 traineeships in Disability IV, 98 traineeships in Mental Health IV were issued.
