RE: COVID-19 UPDATE – Participant Programs and COVID Protocols

In response to NSW achieving more than 28 days without community transmission of COVID-19, NSW Health have updated their advice for disability services. MDS has reviewed this advice and we have updated our COVID protocols.

We will now allow staff to be rostered across the organisation and gradually increase our program offerings in line with existing COVID restrictions. This means you will be offered more choice at your service including attending programs with other MDS sites. Furthermore, there is no longer a requirement for staff to wear a mask whilst providing service except where social distancing cannot be maintained.

Please know if there is another outbreak in NSW we will implement all NSW Health guidelines and return to previous COVID protocols.

In the interests of keeping everyone safe we will continue all other protocols including social distancing, hand hygiene, temperature checks and staff wearing Personal Protective Equipment where required.
